## Management Discussion of Fund Performance

November 12, 2024

This Management Discussion of Fund Performance presents the portfolio management team's view on the significant factors and developments that have affected the Fund's performance and outlook in the six-month period ended September 30, 2024 (the "period"). If the Fund was established during the period, "period" represents the period since inception.

In this report, "Mackenzie" and "the Manager" refer to Mackenzie Financial Corporation, the manager of the Fund. In addition, net asset value ("NAV") refers to the value of the Fund as calculated for transaction purposes, on which the discussion of Fund performance is based.

Investors holding securities of Mackenzie Cundill Value Class were merged into the corresponding series of the Fund on a tax-deferred basis on July 30, 2021. Consequently the information in this report is presented as if the Fund had existed since the inception of Mackenzie Cundill Value Class.

The Fund is closed to new sales.

## Results of Operations

### Investment Performance

The performance of all series in the current and previous periods is shown in the *Past Performance* section of the report. Performance will vary by series primarily because fees and expenses differ between series, or because securities of a series were not issued and outstanding for the entire reporting period. Please refer to the *Fund Formation and Series Information* section of this report for the varying management and administration fees payable by each series. The following comparison to market indices is intended to help investors understand the Fund's performance relative to the general performance of the markets. However, the Fund's mandate may be different from that of the indices shown.

During the period, the Fund's Series A securities returned 2.6% (after deducting fees and expenses paid by the series). This compares with the MSCI World (Net) Index return of 9.0%. All index and series returns are calculated on a total return basis in Canadian dollar terms. Investors cannot invest in an index without incurring fees, expenses and commissions, which are not reflected in the index returns.

Global equity markets generally rose over the period as most central banks began to cut interest rates. Share prices increased in relation to corporate earnings, with gains in U.S. markets driven mainly by a small number of mega-capitalization stocks. The global economy was resilient as inflation continued to slow across most major markets, although unemployment moved slightly higher.

Within the MSCI World (Net) Index, Asia Pacific (ex Japan) and North America were the best-performing regions in Canadian dollar terms, while Japan, Europe, and Africa and the Middle East were the weakest. The utilities, information technology and real estate sectors were the strongest performers, while energy, consumer discretionary and health care were the weakest.

The Fund underperformed the index, with stock selection in the United States and Japan detracting from performance. In sector terms, stock selection in information technology and financials detracted from performance.

Conversely, stock selection in France and the Netherlands contributed to performance. In sector terms, stock selection in consumer discretionary and materials contributed to performance.

Over the period, neither portfolio activity nor market developments significantly changed the positioning of the Fund.

## Net Assets

The Fund's net assets decreased by 7.0% during the period to \$96.2 million. This change was composed primarily of \$2.9 million in net income (including any interest and/or dividend income) from investment performance, after deducting fees and expenses, and a decrease of \$10.1 million due to net securityholder activity (including sales, redemptions and cash distributions).

## Fees and Expenses

The annualized management expense ratio ("MER") for each series during the period ended September 30, 2024, was generally similar to the MER for the year ended March 31, 2024. Total expenses paid vary from period to period mainly as a result of changes in average assets in each series. The MERs for all series are presented in the *Financial Highlights* section of this report.

## Recent Developments

The portfolio management team expects moderate inflation to persist. Despite interest rate cuts by the U.S. Federal Reserve and other central banks, the team believes interest rates are unlikely to return to the lows of 2008–2022.

The team expects stable financial conditions to continue, aided by the rate cuts. Although U.S. labour market metrics weakened in the period, it remained within a reasonable range, while inflation approached central bank targets. In the team's opinion, this environment should support stocks that are sensitive to the economic cycle, and the team therefore increased the Fund's exposure to cyclical stocks with attractive valuations. The team continues to monitor developments in China, where an economic stimulus package was implemented that could boost consumer confidence in the short term.

The following changes to the Mackenzie Funds' Independent Review Committee occurred:

- effective September 13, 2023, Saijal Patel was appointed;
- effective March 5, 2024, Atul Tiwari resigned; and
- effective April 30, 2024, the terms for Robert Hines and George Hucal expired, and Rebecca Cowdery was appointed.

## Related Party Transactions

### Management and Administration Services

For each applicable series, the Fund paid management fees and administration fees to the Manager at the annual rates specified under *Fund Formation and Series Information* in this report and as more fully described in the Prospectus. In return for the administration fees, the Manager pays all costs and expenses (other than certain specified fund costs) required to operate the Fund that are not included in management fees. See also *Management Fees*.

### Other Related Party Transactions

The Fund did not rely on an approval, positive recommendation or standing instruction from the Mackenzie Funds' Independent Review Committee with respect to any related party transactions in the period.

## Past Performance

The Fund's performance information assumes all distributions made by the Fund in the periods presented are reinvested in additional securities of the relevant series of the Fund. The performance information does not take into account sales, redemption, distribution or other optional charges, or income taxes payable by any investor that would have reduced returns or performance. The past performance of the Fund is not necessarily an indication of how it will perform in the future.

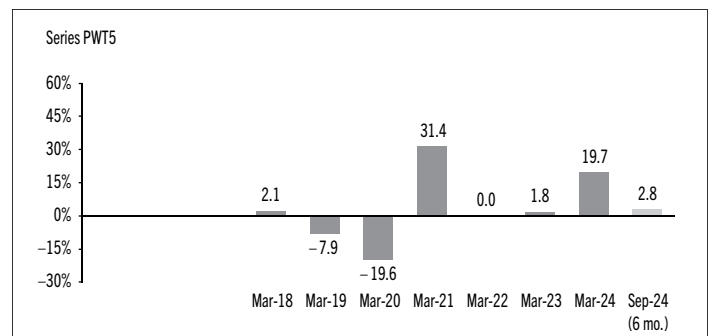
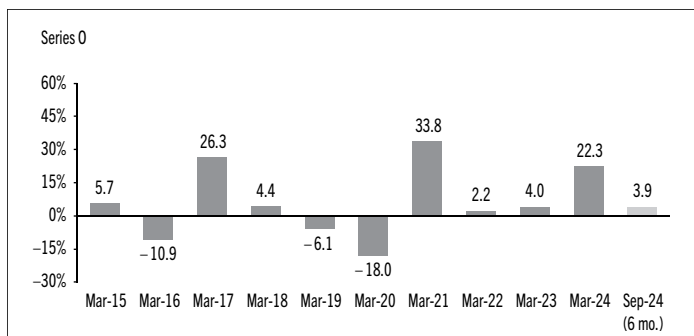
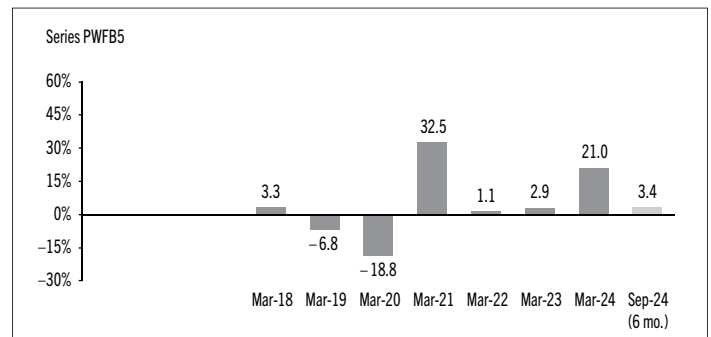
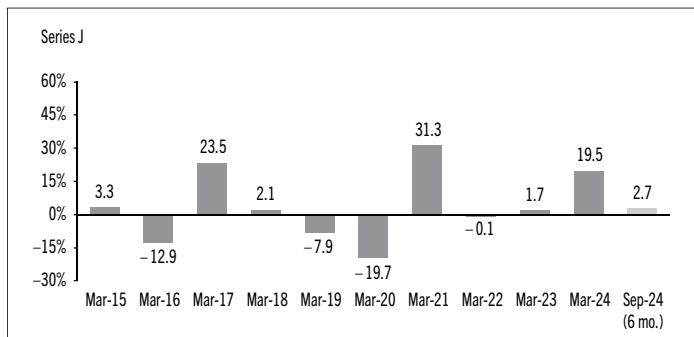
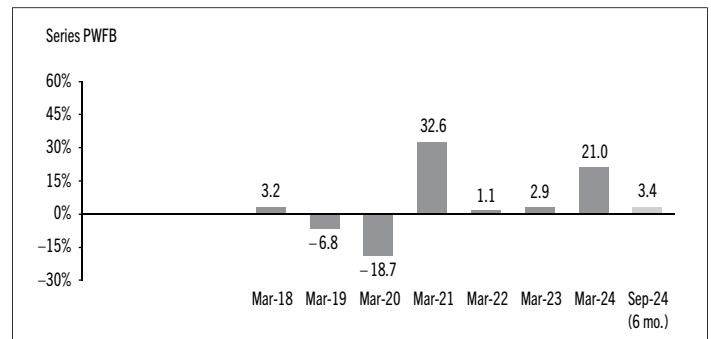
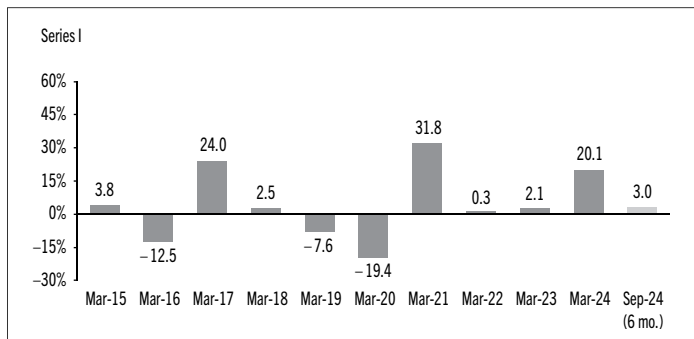
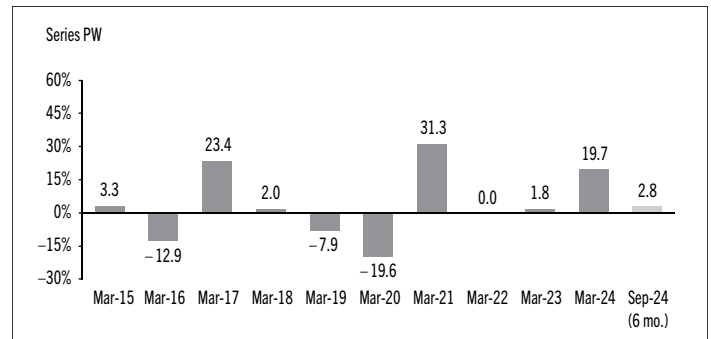
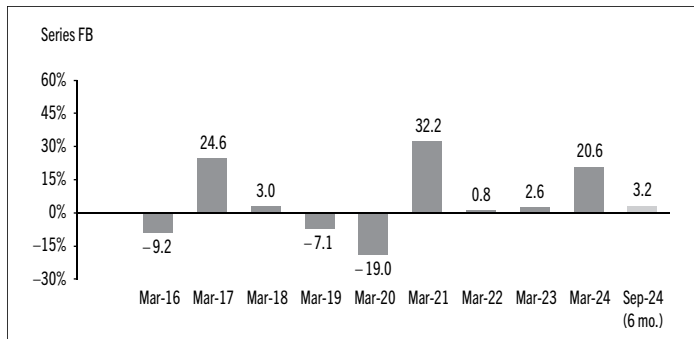
## Year-by-Year Returns

## Management Fees

The management fee for each applicable series is calculated and accrued daily as a percentage of its NAV. The Fund's management fees were used by the Manager to pay for the costs of managing the investment portfolio of the Fund and/or the underlying fund(s), as applicable, including providing investment analysis and recommendations, making investment decisions, making brokerage arrangements for the purchase and sale of the investment portfolio, and providing other services. The Manager also used the management fees to fund sales commissions, trailing commissions and any other compensation (collectively "distribution-related payments") to registered dealers and brokers whose clients invest in the Fund.

The following dealers affiliated with the Manager may be entitled to distribution-related payments from the Manager on the same basis as unrelated registered brokers and dealers: Investors Group Securities Inc. and Investors Group Financial Services Inc.

The Manager used approximately 42% of the total management fee revenues received from all Mackenzie funds during the period to fund distribution-related payments to registered dealers and brokers. In comparison, such distribution-related payments for the Fund represented on average 39% of the management fees paid by all applicable series of the Fund during the period. The actual percentage for each series may be higher or lower than the average depending on the level of trailing commissions and sales commissions paid for that series.
